Rafting on the Rio Grande is one of Jamaica's flagship attractions and an integral part of the socio-economic aspect of the communities of Fellowship, Grants Level, Berrydale, Stony Hill, and St. Margaret's Bay in Portland.

Rio Grande rafting attraction starts at Berrydale in the Rio Grande Valley. This facility is the embarkation site for the trip down the river. The site is 30-40 driving minutes from Port Antonio. From the embarkation site the raft trip is approximately two (2) hours to disembarkation site at Rafter's Rest.

Along the journey sightseeing is at its best, with views of the watershed of the Rio Grande Valley. The forest of Portland has the largest diversity of species of any geographical area of Jamaica, some of which can be seen on the rafting trip. There is also the viewing of agricultural farms along with interspersed communities

Tender Requirements
