Paradise Park

Location: Westmoreland



Paradise Park Estate is just under 1,900 acres of rolling pastures on relatively flat land on Jamaica's southern coast. The eco-park has stretches of unspoilt palm tree forests and wetlands framed by the blue horizon of the Caribbean Sea. The property also has approximately 2,230 feet of white sandy beach on the western side of world famous Bluefields Bay. Paradise Park Estate also has one of the best and longest white sandy beaches in Jamaica, and is ideally suited for hotel and residential development, a small harbour to accommodate pleasure yachts and small boats; as well as two (2) 18-hole golf courses.

The Paradise Estate has a river that runs from the north side of the property into the Caribbean Sea.

Pristine coral reefs lie offshore to the east and west of the opening to Bluefields Bay. A shipwreck lies near the reef to the west of Paradise. The area is ideal for snorkeling and diving.
